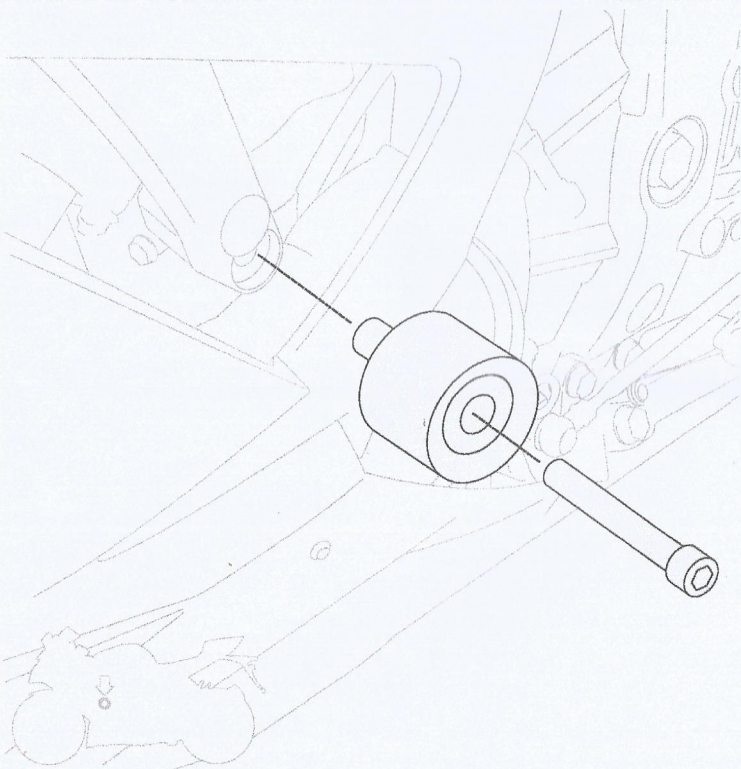


INSTALLATION GUIDE

F.A.Q



You have purchased a motorcycle frame sliders from msliders.com. Sliders are mounted to the frame-engine mounting points.

Installation procedure:

1. Remove the right side frame-engine bolt. If the frame-engine bolts are covered with bike plastics - read the 6th paragraph.
- NOTE - do not remove frame-engine screws from both sides at same time.
2. If sliders and screws are of the same size, you can skip this paragraph. If the sliders are of different size, make sure that the slider fits into selected mounting location, usually the shorter slider is mounted on the right side.
3. After you have removed frame-engine screw, place the slider with a new screw in it's place. Sliders are packed in such a way that the right size screws are already placed inside the sliders.
4. Tighten the sliders using 45nm torque for 10mm bolts and 65nm torque for 12mm bolts. Do not overtighten the sliders. It is recommended to use a thread lock glue.
5. Remove the frame-engine bolt from the hand left side and repeat the previous steps.
6. If your motorcycle frame-engine bolts are covered with plastics, remove the plastic parts and make holes in them for the sliders. You can find the instructions on how to make holes for the sliders here: www.msliders.com/cut.pdf
7. After installing the sliders and riding for about 50km, be sure to check if the bolts are not loose.

1. I received two different size sliders, is that normal?

Yes, that's normal. Bikes are not symmetrical. There are only few models which have same size sliders, usually shorter slider goes on the right hand side.

2. Sliders did not fit my bike, what I can do?

There are many different bike models and modifications. If the sliders you received didn't fit your bike, please check your bike model, year or contact us via email info@msliders.com

3. Is there a way to install the sliders without cutting the plastics?

No. We are selling frame-engine mount sliders only. All our sliders go straight to your bike frame, so if frame-engine mount locations are covered with plastic, you'll need to cut a hole for the slider.

4. Do sliders protect whole bike or do I need additional protection?

Frame sliders are additional protection for your bike, but nothing can protect your bike for 100%. We strongly recommend to use engine cover cases and axle sliders to get more protection.

5. I want to return sliders.

If you have undamaged sliders you can return it and you will receive a full refund for the money you paid. Please contact us via email at info@msliders.com for a return address.

6. I received a damaged item.

If you received a damaged package and your item was damaged, please contact us via email, we'll send you new package as soon as we can.

7. My package was late for a considerable amount of time, it did not arrive on estimated delivery date.
